

Description of activity

Batty bats everywhere

Equipment required

Black paper/card, toilet roll inners, black paint, googly eyes, coloured/patterned paper, glue

Instructions

Using the template cut out some bodies for the bats and wings. Leave some just drawn so the older children can cut their own.

Make up some examples for the children to see and choose from. Use your imagination and do some different versions to hang in messy play and decorate for Halloween.

Let the children make one to take and one to hang so they can see their work on display.

Talk about bats and how they are nocturnal and only come out at dusk and that they live in barns and the roofs of old house and also sometimes hollow trees and caves.
