

Description of activity Paper plate Halloween monsters	Equipment required Paper plates, coloured paper, glue, paint, tissue paper, googly eyes														
Instructions Prepare the additional bits for the characters, arms, hair, legs etc Cut some tissue paper strips for the ghosts Make up an example of each one so the children can pick their favourite one to make. Talk through with the children what they are making, the colours they are using, how many legs and eyes the characters have, where pumpkins grow, where bats live and Halloween in general. Don't be too scary. You could use some of the nursery rhymes on the MP activity cards.
