

<p>Description of activity</p> <p>Paper Plate Hat Making</p>	<p>Equipment required</p> <p>Paper Plates, colouring pens and paper, paints, scissors, various supplies, glitter, pom poms, different colour papers and anything else which can be used to make it colourful, PVA glue.</p>
